- 1. Financial Report for the Election
  - a. Total of \$6,650.31 \$219.39 on hospitality for election day; \$1,182.92 for election supplies; and \$6,650.31 for poll workers
- 2. Citizen of the Year:
  - a. Presented to Harold "Buddy" Goins Sr. which was not present at the meeting. The award was sent to the administrative office to be distributed.
- 3. Cavass of the Election:
  - a. The amount of \$300 was suggested for a ballot recount. Ashley Setterstrom made the motion; Mildred Grooms seconded the motion. A voice vote affirmed the motion.
  - b. Precinct 149 votes were counted and confirmed. A motion to accept the results was made by Paul Liptok and seconded by David Lloyd. A voice vote affirmed the motion.
  - c. Precinct 150 votes were counted and confirmed. A motion to accept the results was made by Dona Lacy and seconded by Paul Liptok. A voice vote affirmed the motion.
  - d. Precinct 151 votes were counted and confirmed. A motion to accept the results was made by Mildred Grooms and seconded by David Lloyd. A voice vote affirmed the motion.
  - A declaration of the results were made which started a 48-hour recount request period where it was agreed upon that council would reconvene via conference call Friday, June 23, 2023 at 8:05 pm to certify the results pending no recount requests.

## **Concerns of the Council:**

- 1. Dona Lacy wanted to revisit the concrete project at Porter Cotton Park.
  - a. David Lloyd stated that the cost would be extremely large to the town if we had a rubber top installed to the basketball court. Stated that we need to focus the spending on the sewer project.
  - Paul Liptok made a motion to move forward with concrete; Mildred Grooms seconded.
    Concerns were discussed about proof that the project had ever been placed out for bid.
    Also discussed was that this project was not on the agenda and could not be voted on.
