


CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION
OF THE TOWN OF CHESAPEAKE,
KANAWHA COUNTY, WEST VIRGINIA.

Certificates under oath of James Foster, Virginia Harrison, Kathryn Hill, Britton Lavender, Frank Lavender, Margaret Ayers, Mrs. Laura Harrison, Clarence Pauley and Kathren Stephan were this day filed showing that a majority of all the qualified voters residing in the following boundary, to-wit: Beginning at a large marked Elm tree at the mouth of Fields creek and the south bank of Kanawha River; thence with the meanderings of Fields creek in a southeasterly direction about 1690 feet to a stake on the west bank thereof, with 14 inch Elm pointer, said stake being 400 feet from the south right-of-way line of the Chesapeake & Ohio Railroad, and 460 feet from the center line of the west bound track; thence running in a northwesterly direction 400 feet from and parallel to said Chesapeake & Ohio right-of-way and 460 feet from the center line of the west bound track approximately 10,200 feet to a stake on the south hill side; thence N. $24^{\circ} 45'$ E. 850 feet to an iron pipe, being the northwest corner of C. G. Miller's lot and the south side of State Highway 61; thence N. $27^{\circ} 21'$ E. 49.74 feet to a concrete monument, being the south east corner of Carbon Fuel Company; thence N. $26^{\circ} 30'$ E. 365 feet to a 16 inch marked Elm at the mouth of a small drain at low water mark on the south side of Kanawha River; thence in a southeasterly direction following the low water mark of Kanawha River and with the meanders thereof approximately 9,680 feet to the place of beginning, and containing approximately 302 acres, all of the aforesaid territory situate in Loudon and Cabin Creek Districts, in Kanawha County, West Virginia, have voted in due form of law in favor of incorporation of the Town

of Chesapeake, Kanawha County, West Virginia, bounded as herein setforth. And as it appears to the satisfaction of the Court that all of the provisions of Chapter 8 of the Code of West Virginia have been complied with by the applicants for said incorporation, said Town is a body corporate, duly authorized within the corporate limits aforesaid, or as otherwise provided, to exercise all the corporate powers conferred by the said Chapter from and after the date of this certificate.
